Call to order:

- A. MINUTES FOR APPROVAL Motion made to approve minutes for the August 20, 2015 meeting.

C. FOLLOW-UP ITEMS

- 1. <u>Req: #2015-177: Permit Parking on Hidden Valley Alta Vista to end of road –</u> <u>Resident Only Parking</u> – Residents to circulate petition.
- 2. <u>Req: #2015-180: Corner of 5th & Genoa Street replace 2 way stop sign with 4 way</u> stop sign.

Staff performed a site visit and stated that there is an East/West stop with red curb. There is a signal a half a block to the South. Recommend traffic engineer review for warrant study.

- <u>Req: #2015-182: Encino Way (Encino Ave & Encino Way) Parking Issue</u> Staff performed a site visit and stated that the street is a very small cul-de-sac with only 5 houses. Painting the curb will result in no parking for residents. Staff will reach out to the residents and determine best solution.
- <u>Req: #2015-183: California & Duarte Rd Traffic issue</u> Stripping is complete. Request was made to hold traffic longer at Myrtle signal. Staff will look into other stripping in area and signal issue at Myrtle.

5. Req: #2015-184: Encino Way (South of Duarte Rd) - Speeding

Same area as parking issues on Encino Way (Req: #2015-182). Staff will check signage and PD will increase patrols.

- 6. <u>Req: #2015-185: 646 N Canyon Blvd Restricted parking in front of residence</u> Resident requesting restricted parking in front of residence. Property is near Canyon Crest cutoff. Per TSC can't restrict parking in area. PD needs to monitor for vandalism.
- 7. <u>Req: #2015-186: 1300 Block of Sherman Ave Permit Only Parking</u> Staff to provide resident with a petition and advise them of the process.
- 8. <u>Req: #2015-187: 710-730 N Canyon No Stopping/No Parking Sign and Red Curb</u> Canyon Park area, need more signage and red curb. Staff to perform site investigation and determine if more signage or curb painting is needed.
- <u>Req: #2015-188: Gold Line Mayflower/Huntington Area</u> Stop sign warrant study needed on Evergreen & Mayflower. No Stopping on Tracks and No Pedestrian Crossing signs needed.

D. AGENDA ITEMS

1. <u>Mauna Loa – Highland – Speeding</u> Requested Data box be placed to monitor speeding.

2. 100 Block E Cypress Between Myrtle & Ivy - Speeding

Morning traffic coming South on Myrtle and hitting the corner at 45 mph going East and in the evening coming off Ivy heading West on Myrtle going 45 mph.

3. Olive & California

4 way stop sign at the corner of Olive and California. Cars have to pull too far forward to see oncoming traffic and there is no crosswalk for pedestrians.

4. 228 E Olive Ave - Blue Curb in front of house

Staff evaluated request. ADA access is limited from the alley to the front unit. Staff recommends Traffic Safety Committee approve blue curb for this residence.

<u>Alta Vista and West Chestnut – 4 way stop</u> Request for 4 way stop at corner of Alta Vista and West Chestnut. Excessive speeding.

- <u>1048 Norumbega Dr Place a mirror on pole for better view of traffic</u> Resident requests to place a mirror on a pole for better view of oncoming traffic when exiting driveway.
- 7. <u>Olive and Primrose Permit Parking only</u> Request for permit parking only.

8. <u>1805 Encino Ave – Speeding</u>

Encino Ave is a narrow street with no sidewalks. Children walk to bus stop in the street. Speeding is an issue.

9. Monrovia High School Area – Traffic/Parking

Add handicapped parking on Colorado in front of the main walkway; add pedestrian crosswalk in front of the school on Colorado; add bus parking zone on Madison; traffic signals at Madison and Foothill re-timed.
