TITLE: Wilderness Preserve Foundation Member Recruitment

**OBJECTIVE:** Update the Foundation Board on new member recruitment strategies

**BACKGROUND:** At the January 12, 2016 Board meeting, Staff requested information and direction from the Board related to the next steps for the Wilderness Preserve Foundation.

Specifically, the Board has been working towards answering two operational questions:

- Should the focus of the Wilderness Preserve Foundation remain specific to the Hillside Wilderness Preserve, or should the purpose be expanded to serve a more broad perspective?
- Who should serve as the Foundation Board Members? Should the Commissioners continue to wear two hats, or should others be included on the Board?

The Board was hesitant to make a recommendation related to the next steps for the Foundation as they may not be the future Board members. The belief is new members should be sought and seated allowing this new leadership the opportunity to establish the Foundations purpose. As a result, the Board requested Staff look into recruiting new potential members to serve on the Board.

**ANALYSIS:** At the end of 2015, Staff reached out to various potential new members including those who previously served on the Trails Committee as well as the Canyon Park Volunteer group. To date, Staff has not been successful with seeking potential new members. It was suggested that new marketing strategies be deployed to garner more interest. Staff has outlined several approaches to increase marketing / promotions of opportunities which will be deployed over the next 90 days.
