**TITLE:** Infrastructure Maintenance Deputy Director Report

**OBJECTIVE:** The purpose of this report is to provide the Community Services Commission with a brief update on projects, and maintenance programs currently being worked on by the Public Works Department.

Canyon Park

- Work continues on the sewer/septic tank system.
- The roof on the middle restroom facility has been repaired.
- The ceiling fans in the cabin have been repaired.

Community Center

• City staff has been getting estimates for the Kay Dalton Room repairs.

Grand Avenue Park

- The Redwood trees at the Grand Avenue entrance to the Park have been removed, and will be replaced with an Oak tree.
- Work began on January 29 for an irrigation system upgrade as a part of a grant from Upper San Gabriel Municipal Water District.

Julian Fisher Park

- The City has been notified that we have received a grant for \$250,000 from Los Angeles County for replacement of the basketball courts, and other improvements at the park. This was not the entire amount we requested. We will begin preparations soon.
- The dead Oak tree has been removed.

Library and Park

- The Morton Bay Fig has developed stress cracks in one of the large branches. The tree was trimmed by West Coast Arborists, and a new support was built by Public Woks staff. We will continue to monitor the area.
- The fountain on the Northwest corner of Myrtle and Lime Avenues was damaged by a vehicle The Monrovia Historic Preservation Group completed the reconstruction of the roof structure. The Group is requesting assistance with the installation of the tiles.

Lucinda Garcia Park (Olive Avenue)

• Public Works staff applied for a Los Angeles County Grant to replace the playground equipment, and make several other improvements; unfortunately this grant was not approved.

**Recreation Park** 

- Graffiti at the Skate Park, restrooms, museum and Boys and Girls Club.
- Repairs were made to the fixtures at the Ball Field restrooms.

Rotary Park

• The existing park sign was repainted, and looks great.
