TITLE: Infrastructure Maintenance Division Managers Report

**OBJECTIVE:** The purpose of this report is to provide the Community Services Commission with a brief update on projects, and maintenance programs currently being worked on by the Public Works Department.

Canyon Park

- Work continues on the sewer/septic tank system.
- Several repairs made at the restrooms.

## **Community Center**

• The parking lot and entrance area were cleared and mulched as part of Make a Difference Day.

Grand Avenue Park

- The installation of the equipment purchased from the Dove Pre-school has been installed along with a set of swings. The opening was November 22, and was very well attended.
- A new drinking fountain has been constructed by Public Works using re-purposed materials.
- 4 Benches received from the recycling grant were installed.
- The new solar lights have been installed at the playground equipment.
- The Redwood trees at the Grand Avenue entrance to the Park have been removed and will be replaced with an Oak tree.

Julian Fisher Park

- Public works staff has applied for a L.A. County grant for replacement of the basketball courts and other improvements at the park.
- Remove dead Oak tree after approval (on removal schedule)
- 3 benches received from the recycling grant were installed.
- Graffiti has been removed from the walls and park sign.

Library and Park

- The fountain on the Northwest corner of Myrtle and Lime was damaged by vehicle The Monrovia Historical Group is assisting with the reconstruction of the roof structure. The Historical Group is scheduling the installation of the replacement materials.
- Repairs were made to the park irrigation system.
- The playground surface has been repaired.

## CC-2

- The area around the Fountain was replanted as a project on Make a Difference Day.
- Repaired lighting in the Library.
- The City Christmas Tree has been decorated and will be lit on December 4.

Lucinda Garcia Park (Olive Ave)

- Public Works staff applied for a L.A. County Grant to replace the playground equipment and make several other improvements.
- Graffiti was removed.

Recreation Park

- Graffiti at the Skate Park, restrooms, museum and Boys and Girls Club.
- The landscaping around the Mary Wilcox Center was replaced as part of the Make a Difference Day work projects.
- The curb along the west side of the Skate Park has been painted red at the request of the Monrovia Police Department for better visibility into the Park.
- Repairs were made to the irrigation systems.
