TITLE: Infrastructure Maintenance Division Managers Report

OBJECTIVE: The purpose of this report is to provide the Community Services Commission with a brief update on projects, and maintenance programs currently being worked on by the Public Works Department.

14 ADA style picnic benches have been approved as a part of a recycling grant and will be distributed in the Parks System.

Canyon Park

• Work continues on the sewer/septic tank system.

Community Center

- The HVAC for the Senior Game Room was repaired.
- Repaired lights in the Kay Dalton Room.

Grand Avenue Park

- Funding has been approved to install the playground equipment purchased from the Dove School last year. Installation will begin in mid-October.
- The drinking fountain that was being repaired was stolen.
- Work is continuing on the irrigation system.
- Several trees were trimmed by West Coast Arborists.

Julian Fisher Park

- Public works staff has applied for a L.A. County grant for replacement of the basketball courts and other improvements at the park.
- Remove dead Oak tree after approval.

Library and Park

- The contractor hired to repair the fountain on the northwest corner of Myrtle and Lime (damaged by a vehicle) has completed the masonry work needed. The Monrovia Historical Group is assisting with the reconstruction of the roof structure. The replacement wood has been delivered.
- Repairs were made to the park irrigation system.
- The planter area around the front doors was replanted.
- Repaired lighting in the Library.

CC-2

- Reset the HVAC system at the Friends Bookstore.
- Installed fans in the Fountain vault.

Lucinda Garcia Park (Olive Ave)

- Public Works staff applied for a L.A. County Grant to replace the playground equipment and make several other improvements.
- Graffiti was removed.

Recreation Park

- Graffiti at the Skate Park, restrooms, museum and Boys and Girls Club.
- Repaired lighting in the Mary Wilcox Youth Center.
- Reset the HVAC at The Boys and Girls Club building.

Rotary Park

- Graffiti at various locations.
- Several trees were trimmed by West Coast Arborists.
