TITLE: Infrastructure Division Manager's Report

OBJECTIVE: The purpose of this report is to provide the Community Services Commission with a brief update on projects, and maintenance programs currently being worked on by the Public Works Department.

Canyon Park

- Work continues on the sewer/septic tank system.
- Plumbing repairs were made in the restrooms.
- The alarm system phone line was repaired by Verizon.

Community Center

- Plumbing repairs were made in the restrooms.
- The floor in the Kay Dalton Room was refinished.
- Repairs were made to the swinging door in the lobby.

Grand Avenue Park

- Funding has been approved to install the playground equipment purchased from the Dove School last year. Installation will begin in October.
- Vandals stole over a dozen of the large sprinkler heads.
- The fence was cut and vandalized at the north side of the park (temporary repairs made)
- Several trees were removed and others trimmed by West Coast Arborists.

Julian Fisher Park

- Construction of the playground equipment was completed, and the Grand Opening Ceremony was held on Saturday, August 2.
- Public works staff has applied for a L.A. County grant for replacement of the basketball courts and other improvements at the park.

Library and Park

• The fountain on the Northwest corner of Myrtle and Lime Avenues was damaged by a vehicle. The contractor has completed the masonry work needed. The Monrovia Historic Preservation Group is assisting with the reconstruction of the roof structure.

CC-2

- Repairs were made to the park irrigation system.
- Repairs were made to the playground surface.

Lucinda Garcia Park (Olive Ave)

- Public Works staff applied for a L.A. County Grant to replace the playground equipment and make several other improvements.
- Graffiti was removed.

Recreation Park

- Graffiti at the Skate Park, restrooms, museum and Boys and Girls Club.
- Repairs were made to the HVAC and stove ventilator at the Boys and Girls Club.
- The HVAC roof unit was vandalized at the Mary Wilcox Youth Center.
- Repairs were made to the lighting in the Basketball Court area of the Youth Center.
- Several damaged concrete electrical boxes were replaced at the skate park.
