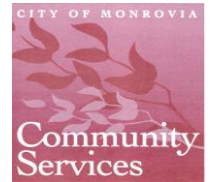

TITLE: Infrastructure Maintenance Division Manager's Report

OBJECTIVE: The purpose of this report is to provide the Community Services Commission with a brief update on projects, and maintenance programs currently being worked on by the Public Works Department.

Canyon Park

- Work continues on the sewer/septic tank system.
- Replaced the Nature Center door
- Repaired middle restroom faucet

Grand Avenue Park

- Swings damaged – we were able to replace 1 swing.
- Graffiti removed
- Fence cut and vandalized at the north side of the park (temporary repairs made)
- Drinking fountain damaged, repair completed

Julian Fisher Park

- Construction of the playground site began on June 17th.
- Graffiti removed

Library and Park

- Fountain on the Northwest corner of Myrtle and Lime was damaged by vehicle – The request to hire a masonry contractor was approved by Council on 5 8 14. The Monrovia Historical Group will be assisting with the reconstruction of the roof structure.
