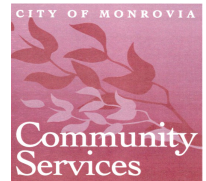

TITLE: Infrastructure Maintenance Division Manager's Report

OBJECTIVE: The purpose of this report is to provide the Community Services Commission with a brief update on projects, and maintenance programs currently being worked on by the Public Works Department.

Canyon Park

- Work continues on the sewer/septic tank system.

Community Center

- Repairs to the Directors office were completed
- The drinking fountain was replaced.

Grand Avenue Park

- Swings damaged – we were able to replace 1 swing.
- Graffiti removed
- Fence cut and vandalized at the north side of the park (temporary repairs made)
- Drinking fountain damaged, replacement parts on order

Julian Fisher Park

- On May 20 the City Council approved the hiring of a contractor (Creative Contractors) to install the playground equipment. Work should begin the end of June.
- Graffiti removed

Library and Park

- Fountain on the Northwest corner of Myrtle and Lime was damaged by vehicle – The request to hire a masonry contractor was approved by City Council at the May 8 meeting. The Monrovia Historic Preservation Group will assist with the reconstruction of the roof structure.
- Ceiling light replacements in lobby continue.

Lucinda Garcia Park (Olive Ave)

- Graffiti removed

Recreation Park

- Graffiti at the Skate Park, restrooms, Historical Museum and Boys and Girls Club.
- Termite treatment was done at the Boys and Girls Club May 16 to 18.
- The drinking fountain at the Boys and Girls club vandalized - repaired

Rotary Park

- Graffiti at various locations
