OBJECTIVE: The purpose of this report is to provide the Community Services Commission with a brief update on projects, and maintenance programs currently being worked on by the Public Works Department.

Canyon Park

- Work continues on the sewer line in the roadway
- Repaired the toilet plumbing Canyon Park entry station
- Checked lighting in the Nature Center restroom

Community Center

Grand Avenue Park
