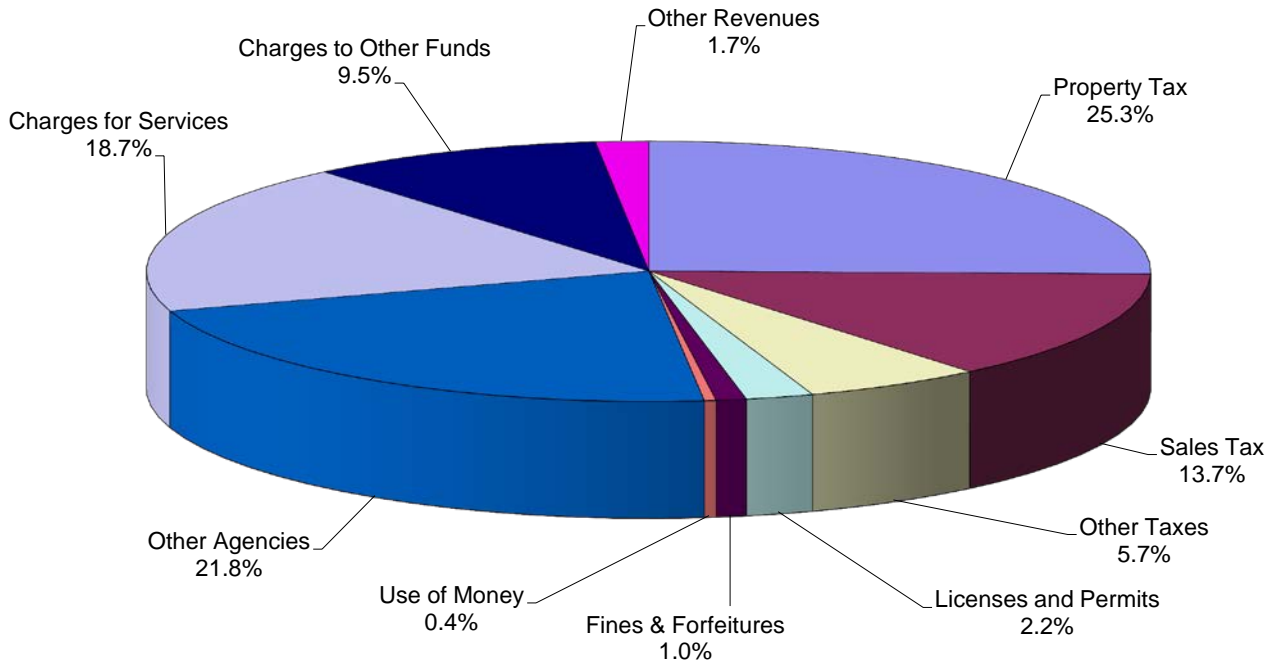

<b><u>PROPERTY TAXES:</u></b> Revenues received as a result of the levy of taxes upon the real value of personal property. Includes levies against the secured, unsecured, and utility rolls, and all penalties and interest on delinquent taxes.	\$17,906,042	25.3%	\$18,470,224	27.5%
<b><u>SALES TAX:</u></b> Taxes imposed upon the sale or consumption of goods and services in the City. Current state level is 7.25%, which includes a Public Safety tax of 1/2% for police and fire operations. Revenues equal 1% of taxable sales.	\$9,614,484	13.7%	\$9,967,295	14.8%
<b><u>OTHER TAXES:</u></b> Revenue derived from property transfer, business fees, license transit occupancy taxes, and utility franchise fees.	\$4,026,916	5.7%	\$4,060,753	6.0%
<b><u>LICENSES AND PERMITS:</u></b> Revenue received from the issuance of licenses and permits within the city of Monrovia, such as animal licenses, building permits, waste hauler permits, etc.	\$1,523,550	2.2%	\$1,423,050	2.1%
<b><u>FINES, FORFEITURES, AND PENALTIES:</u></b> Monies derived from the City's share of fines and penalties imposed by the courts for vehicle code and other statutory violations.	\$682,450	1.0%	\$682,450	1.0%
<b><u>USE OF MONEY AND PROPERTY:</u></b> Revenue received from the rental of land, buildings, equipment and interest from investment of City funds.	\$263,100	0.4%	\$263,100	0.4%
<b><u>REVENUE FROM FEDERAL, STATE &amp; OTHER AGENCIES:</u></b> Revenues commonly called subventions and grants. Monies received by the City, the distribution of which is controlled by some other agency.	\$15,337,151	21.8%	\$11,414,239	16.9%
<b><u>CHARGES FOR SERVICE:</u></b> Revenue from all charges for specific services provided by the City, such as engineering and plan checks, park and recreation fees, water service charges, etc.	\$13,196,513	18.7%	\$12,982,126	19.3%
<b><u>CHARGES TO OTHER FUNDS:</u></b> Revenue from all charges to other departments within the City. Examples include charges to cover insurance costs, technology support, facility maintenance, and vehicle replacements.	\$6,682,493	9.5%	\$6,695,885	9.9%
<b><u>OTHER REVENUES:</u></b> Miscellaneous and one-time revenues not falling into any other classification, including the sale of property and loan proceeds.	\$1,201,593	1.7%	\$1,424,478	2.1%
