Be good stewards of the Preserve. Respect the ecosystem and adjacent private properties. Hours are subject to change.

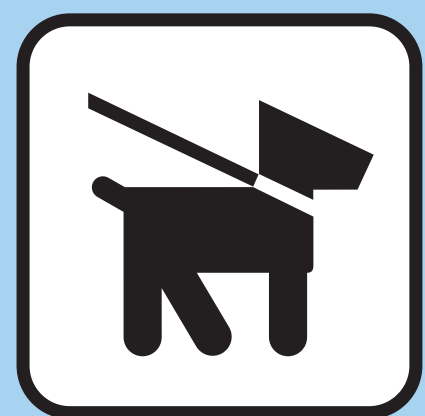
